

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 14 February 2011, the provider notified us that a child left the building unsupervised. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements relating to 'suitable people'. In particular, to notify Ofsted particulars of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for, or is in regular contact with, children on the premises to look after children.

The provider took prompt and appropriate action to comply with the requirements of registration by securing an inner-door so that when one room is not in use, the unused section of the building can be closed off; and procedures were reviewed with members of staff.

We discussed this matter with the provider by telephone and conducted an unannounced visit. We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
