

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 4 July 2011 the provider notified us that allegations had been made against a member of staff. The notification of this significant event means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Early Years Foundation Stage welfare requirements relating to 'Suitable people'.

Although the manager failed to report the incident in line with their safeguarding procedures the provider took action to meet the requirements of registration by informing the relevant agencies of the allegations which related to 'Safeguarding and promoting children's welfare'. They conducted a provider investigation and informed Ofsted of the action they had taken.

We contacted the provider 27 July 2011 to discuss the impact of the action they had taken and to ensure all staff understand their roles and responsibilities. We found that satisfactory steps have been put in place to ensure staff are well informed and supervision promotes the safety and welfare of children. We are satisfied with the action the provider has taken to ensure they continue to meet the requirements for registration. As a result, we decided it was not necessary for us to take any action.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
